Patient Check List

Please read and understand the below requirements before you begin		
	Verify You have all Kit Contents: 1 Test Requisition Form 1 Cardboard Box – please save and refer to shipping instructions 1 Urine Specimen Jar 1 Zip-lock Bag 1 Silver Thermo Bag 1 Freezer Pack (Polar Pack Gel) 1 Absorbent Material 1 Pre-paid Courier Bag	
	Place the Freezer Pack into the freezer.	
	To avoid dilution of the specimen, limit liquid intake starting at 6pm the night prior to collection period.	
	Female patients should not collect urine during a menstrual period.

First mor	ning void before food or drink is suggested. Fasting for 12 hours may the excretion of mycotoxins from the adipose tissue. However, fasting is namended if running this test in combination with other urine tests.

	If completing the 'Organic Acids Test', please refrain from consuming the following for a minimum of 48 hours prior to collection	
	Fruit Juice, Jelly, Bananas, Apples, Pears, Plums / Prunes, Cranberries, Kiwi, Pineapple, Avocado, Walnut, Pecan, Arabinogalactan, Echinacea, Reishi Mushrooms and Ribose Supplements	
	Please refrain from taking <u>non-essential</u> medications / supplements 48 hours prior to and during the specimen collection, as authorised or alternatively advised by your practitioner.	

Best Day To Collect

Ideally, complete test by Sunday and ship on Monday
(after an overnight freeze)

First Morning Urine Collection

- Fill out the **Test Requisition Form (PRINT CLEARLY)** and sign it.

 The test cannot be performed without a properly filled out Requisition Form.
- When you arise, collect your first morning urination into the Urine Specimen Jar BEFORE eating or drinking.

 Fill the Urine Specimen Jar up to the top of the white label and then tighten the screw-cap securely. Do not overfill Urine Specimen Jar.
- Urine must be yellow in colour, if urine is clear the sample is too dilute and you will need to collect a new sample. You will need a fresh Urine Specimen Jar.



- Write the patient's name, the date and time of collection, and the patient's date of birth on the Urine Specimen Jar

 The test cannot be performed without the patient information on the Urine Specimen Jar. Ensure the patient name on the Urine Specimen Jar is identical to the Test Requisition Form.
- Place the Urine Specimen Jar with the Absorbent Material inside the Zip-lock Bag. Place the Test Requisition Form in the outer sleeve of Zip-lock Bag.
- Place the Freezer Pack and Zip-lock Bag into Silver Thermo Pack and place in the freezer overnight (sample needs to be frozen solid)

Organise Shipping

To ship specimen, retrieve the Silver Thermo Bag from the freezer (containing the frozen specimen, freezer pack and test requisition form). Place into the cardboard box, and put the box into the Pre-Paid Courier bag and then send to FxMed.

Ideally complete test on Sunday morning. Freeze overnight

and then send to FxMed, first thing Monday morning so we

- receive it by Tuesday. We then courier all samples to Great Plains Lab on Wednesday morning every week.

 Please call NZ Courier on 0800 800 841, when your sample is ready to be picked up. Tell the operator you have a "Pre-Paid Pickup" and give your location and, for your convenience, check as to what time they will pick up.
 - Please note: if you are a rural customer, the courier may not be able to collect the sample directly from your property so you may have to drop your sample off at the nearest courier depot.
 - South Island patients Please inform the courier that you have an urgent pick-up



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
